

**Impact of Veteran Voices & Visions Peer Support
Groups on Social Integration for Veterans with
SMI/Psychosis**

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Statistical Analysis

Descriptive statistics such as means with standard deviation and relative frequency were presented for the sample demographics. Changes in outcome measures from pre-Intervention assessment to post-Intervention were assessed using mixed effects linear regression models with person random intercept and nested random slope for time. Fixed effects for time (pre vs post assessment) were used to quantify the magnitude of change over time. Bivariate differences in demographics and baseline scores between those with and without complete follow-up were examined to understand the plausibility of the Missing at Random assumptions underlying the mixed effects modeling approach. Sensitivity analyses were used to restrict to participants who had measures at both pre- and post- Intervention assessments. Model estimates were presented as both in the original units and as normalized units (i.e. Glass's Delta). All analyses utilized a two-sided alpha level of 0.05 for determining statistical significance and were conducted in Stata version 19.1, Stata Corp LLC (College Station, Texas).
